Paul

Romans 6

- GOD FORBID. How shall we, that are DEAD TO SIN, live any longer therein?
- Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, THAT THE BODY OF SIN MIGHT BE DESTROYED, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
- For he that is dead is FREED FROM SIN.

- Awake to righteousness, and SIN NOT; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame. 1 Corinthians 15:34
- Exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the *deceitfulness of sin*. Hebrews 3:13
- For *if we sin willfully* after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, Hebrews 10:26
- Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us LAY ASIDE every weight, and THE SIN which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us. Hebrews 12:1

Chapter 3	HE THAT COMMITTETH SIN IS OF THE DEVIL;	for the devil sinneth from the beginning.	For this purpose was the Son of God manifested,
Chapter 5	We know that whosoever is born of God	SINNETH NOT;	but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself



From THE OLD TESTAMENT

Ex 20:20

And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.

It is a choice. God says,

Ezekiel 18:4-9

Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: **the soul that sinneth**, **it shall die**. But if a man be just, and do that which is lawful and right, *And* hath not eaten upon the mountains, neither hath lifted up his eyes to the idols of the house of Israel, neither hath defiled his neighbour's wife, neither hath come near to a menstruous woman,

And hath not oppressed any, but hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment; he that hath not given forth upon usury, neither hath taken any increase, that hath withdrawn his hand from iniquity, hath executed true judgment between man and man, Hath walked in my statutes, and hath kept my judgments, to deal truly; he is just, he shall surely live, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 18:30-32

Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn *yourselves* from all your transgressions; **so iniquity shall not be your ruin**.

Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel? For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith the Lord GOD: wherefore turn yourselves, and live ye.

Zephaniah 3:13

The remnant of Israel **shall not do iniquity**, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make *them* afraid.

Ezekiel 3:21

Nevertheless if thou warn the righteous man, that the righteous **sin not**, and he **doth not sin**, he shall surely live, because he is warned; also thou hast delivered thy soul.

Psalm 4:4

Stand in awe, and **sin not**: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.

Psalm 39:1

I said, I will take heed to my ways, that I sin not with my tongue: I will keep my mouth with a bridle, while the wicked is before me.

2 Samuel 22:21-24

Psalm 32:2

Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD **imputeth not iniquity**, and in whose spirit there is no guile.

2 Chronicles 19:6-7

(Jehoshaphat) said to the judges, Take heed what ye do: for ye judge not for man, but for the LORD, who is with you in the judgment. Wherefore now let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take heed and do it: for **there is no iniquity with the LORD** our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts.

Job 34:31-32

Surely it is meet to be said unto God, I have borne chastisement, I will not offend any more: That which I see not teach thou me: **if I have done iniquity**, *I will do no more*.

Jeremiah 50:20

Where Did The Apostles Get "Sin No More"?



Matthew 7:22-23

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: **depart from me, ye that work iniquity**.

2 Timothy 2:19

Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let **every one** that nameth the name of Christ **depart from iniquity**.

Hebrews 10:26-27

For **if we sin wilfully** after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth **no more sacrifice for sins**, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

1 Corinthians 15:34

Awake to righteousness, **and sin not**; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.

1 John 2:1

My little children, these things write I unto you, that **ye sin not**. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

1 Peter 4:1-2

Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh **hath ceased from sin**; That he no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.

1 John 3:7-9

Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. *He that committeth sin is of the devil*; for the devil sinneth from the beginning.

For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he CANNOT SIN, because he is born of God.
